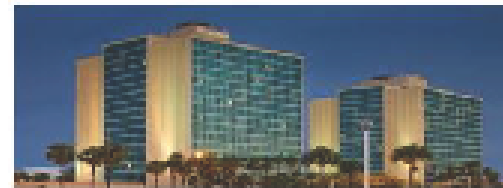

In light of the requirements of Executive Order 13807, *Establishing Discipline and Accountability in the Environmental Review and Permitting Process for Infrastructure Projects*, the National Association of Environmental Professionals (NAEP) developed a White Paper on Best Practices for Implementing the Procedural Provisions of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).
