Serve on the NAEP National Board as an At-Large Board Member!

The NAEP Board of Directors meets four times each year at various locations around the country. It is recommended that this be done in person; however, conference call-in attendance is allowed. The meetings are normally held on a Saturday and last for 6-8 hours. Each Board meets for the first time at the end of the annual conference immediately after the installation of officers. The Board meets again at various locations around the country approximately three, six, and nine months after the annual conference. As a voluntary association, there is no reimbursement for travel expenses or the other costs associated with being on the Board of Directors. Because NAEP has only recently changed to 15 elected at-large Board Members, this year it will need to elect seven Board Members. The sixth and seventh nominees with the lowest number of votes will serve a special first term of either one year or two years. Between Board meetings, the Board of Directors is represented by a five-member Executive Committee. The Executive Committee meets at the discretion of the NAEP President, normally twice-monthly by conference calls. To be eligible to serve on the Executive Committee you must have served as a Board Member for at least one-year prior to your election as an Officer of the Association.
